We had a great turn out for our June Chapter meeting.

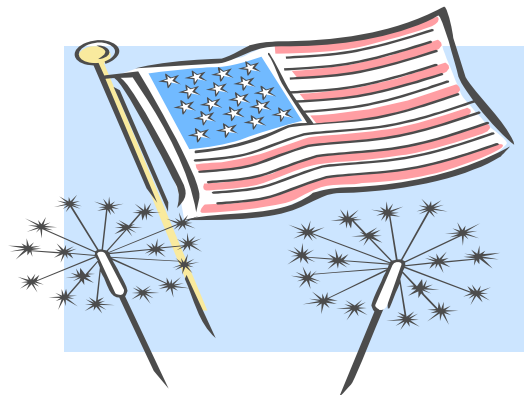
Chapter P from Lexington took home the Traveling Plaque.

Beating the Heat This Summer

As temperatures rise, it's important for us to be careful about the heat-related issues. There are two illnesses that we as Motorcyclists are target for, and they are heat exhaustion and heat stroke.

Heat exhaustion is a warning that a person's body is getting too hot. A person who is experiencing heat exhaustion may be thirsty, pale, weak, uncoordinated, and even nauseous. They may even experience excessive sweating, muscle cramps, and their breathing may even get rapid and shallow. The body temperature is usually normal and the pulse is normal or raised. The skin is often cold and clammy.

Heat stroke on the other hand can be life-threatening! A person who is experiencing this will have a body temperature of 104. Some of the symptoms are lack of sweating, strong rapid pulse, fainting, dry flushed skin, or even coma.

We as motorcyclists can and should do all that we can do to prevent these illnesses by doing the following:

Drink plenty of fluids (preferably water); do not drink anything that has a lot of sugar, or caffeine.

Rest.

Schedule your ride to start out later in the evenings in the cooler part of night, or early in mornings before the sun gets too hot.

Just remember one important thing TAKE CARE of NO. 1 while out having fun on these hot summer days. We want everyone to come home safely.

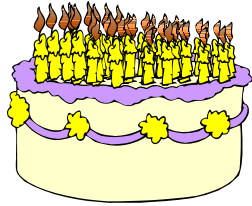

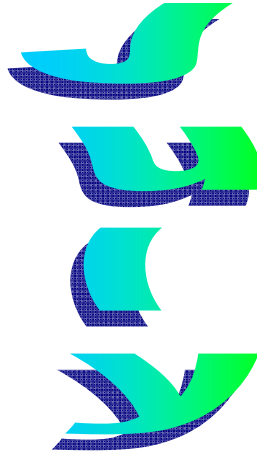
